Outdoor Living Project of the Year:

The outdoor living area of this house in Forrest extends the entire length of the dwell-

ing creating a continuous link from inside to outside.

North-facing and boasting remarkable views over the heart of Canberra, the terrace includes a fully serviced two-way fireplace, an outdoor kitchen and plenty of space for entertaining and relaxing.

Built by Chase Building Group, designed by Architects Ring & Associates with interiors by Archetec, the outdoor living area complements the house to create a complete design adding to the fact the house has also been selected as a finalist for the House of the Year award.
